

V angleščini imamo pravilne in nepravilne glagole. Če so glagoli pravilni, dobijo v pretekliku le končnico –ed, če pa so glagoli nepravilni, se moramo njihove posebne oblike naučiti na pamet.


On August 1st they arrived at Heathrow airport. They checked in and waited for the plane to leave. Six hours later they landed at a big airport and changed planes.

- d Communication Sydney p.112 and read about what happened to Emma and Raoul in the end. Is it easy to make a mistake like this?




